What does a Panel Technician do?

Panel Technicians (also known as Body Repair Technicians) specialise in repairing or replacing damaged panels on our customer's vehicles.

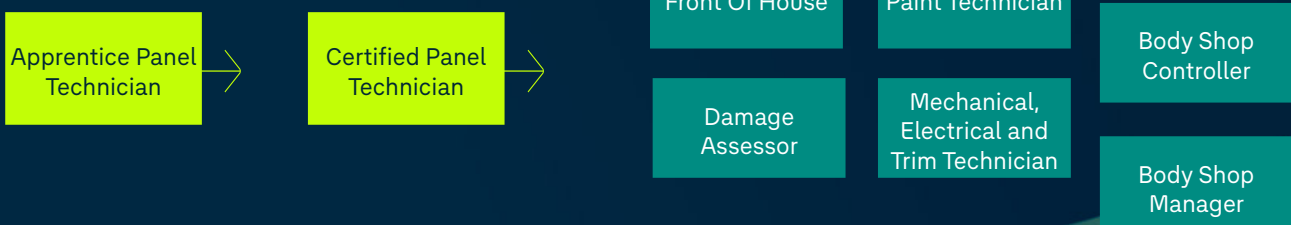

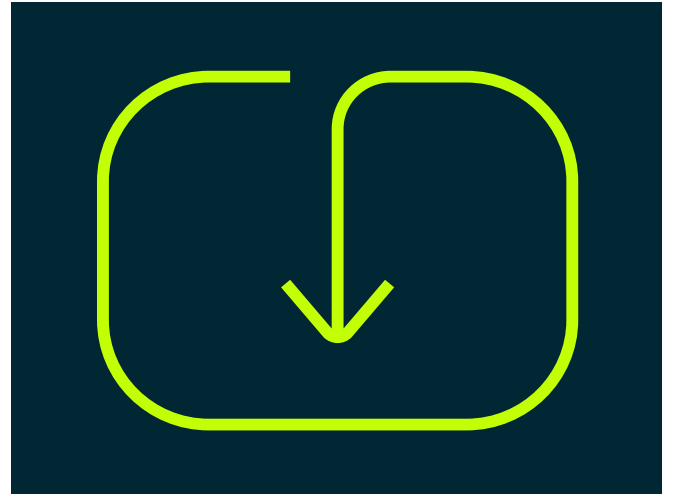
Daily duties will vary according to location and may include:

- Removing damaged panels.
- Repairing damaged chassis and panels.
- Keeping logs of work carried out and informing customers of any additional works.

- Using sophisticated diagnostic equipment to determine correct alignment of the vehicles structure.
